Mandatory Online Team Registration sent via Email

Deadline: Monday, November 21, 2011 @ midnight

All teams must register or “check in” their team prior to the start of the tournament. We are not offering onsite registration so all teams must register their team via email. The deadline for online registration is November 21st @ midnight. No Extensions will be allowed.

Instructions on how to register via email:

1. Print and fill out the document labeled “NSCAA College Showcase – Midwest Team Information Sheet.” The document is found on the Elite Tournaments website: http://www.elitetournaments.com/10_accepted.php
- 2a. US Club Teams need to provide:
 - 1 copy of the US Club Roster (see “Frequently Asked Questions” below about adding guest players)
 - A copy of each US Club Players Passes (front and back must be copied)
 - A copy of each guest players US Club Player Passes (front and back must be copied)
- 2b. US Youth Soccer Teams need to provide:
 - 1 copy of the State Approved Roster (see “Frequently Asked Questions” below about adding guest players)
 - A copy of each US Youth Soccer Player Passes (front and back must be copied)
 - A copy of each guest players US Youth Soccer Player Passes (front and back must be copied)
 - A copy of the Permission to Travel (If applicable)
3. After you have gathered the appropriate documents to register your team please follow the following instructions:
 - a. Scan each document and save the files as a PDF (**We will not accept other file types i.e. JPEG, Zip Drive or Word document**)
 - b. Combine all files before sending into **one document** (we will not accept the document if it is more than one file)
 - c. Email the document to mschmidt@elitetournaments.com
 - In the subject line of the email include the following
 - Baltimore College Showcase or Junior Showcase
 - Full team name (include Club and team name)
 - Gender
 - Age

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Registration Confirmation:

Will I receive an email confirming that my roster has been approved?

Yes- all teams will receive an email confirming their roster has been approved. This email will be sent after the deadline.

Players not attending the event:

If a player is not attending the event do I leave their name on the roster?

No- if a player is not attending the event you need to cross their name off of the roster.

Guest Players:

What is the maximum number of guest players a team can bring to the event?

A maximum of six (6) guest players will be allowed during the tournament.

The following are the maximum roster size per age groups:

U12 – U15 (Full –sided) – 18 players

U16 - U19 (Full-sided) - 22 Players, but only 18 may dress for any given game.

How do I add a guest player?

Step 1: Obtain the guest players current player card and medical release form

Step 2: Add the guest player to the roster. Please handwrite their full name, unique jersey number, player identification number and birthday below the existing rostered players.

Note: US Club Soccer teams may only take guest players registered under US Club Soccer, and USYSA teams may only take guest players registered with properly stamped USYSA player pass cards. No roster may be comprised of players with different passes from different organizations (no “mixed rosters”).

How do I add a guest player after I emailed my registration information?

Teams will not be allowed to resubmit their roster online. Instead teams will be allowed to resubmit their roster at Covenant Park on Friday, November 25th during games being played. First we ask that you resubmit the roster 1 hour before your first game is played and we also ask that teams print 2 copies of the roster that was approved by Elite Tournaments to the tournament head quarters at Covenant Park (one copy of your roster will be left with the tournament Head quarters tent).

Medical Release Forms

What medical release forms are acceptable?

Any type of medical release form is acceptable. If your team needs to fill out a medical release form you can find the form on the following page (Right column at the bottom of the page) http://www.elitetournaments.com/10_home.php

Do I include the medical release forms in the early registration document?

- All teams must have a medical release form for each player (including guest players) but **DO NOT** include the medical release forms in the online registration package.

T-shirt Pre-Order Pick up Location
