What to do once Applied for the Event

Mail in Payment

Option 1: After you have applied, please mail in your application payment and performance bond (only applicable for teams competing in the U15 and above age groups) to the following address:

Application fee checks and performance bond checks are separate payments and need to be made payable to "Championship Tournaments"

Mandatory On-site Registration

**ALL TEAMS MUST REGISTER (check-in)
On- Site 1 hour before your first game is played**

What to bring for On-site Registration:

1. Two copies of your USYS State Association or US Club approved roster to be submitted to the tournament committee
2. Player passes for every participating player (including guest players)
3. Medical releases for every participating player (including guest players)
4. A copy of the state association's permission to travel. Please check with your state association to find out if this document is required for your specific team.

FAQs about Guest Players

What is the maximum number of guest players a team can bring to the event?

A maximum of four (4) guest players will be allowed during the tournament.

How do I add a guest player?

Step 1: Obtain the guest players current player card and medical release form

Step 2: Add the guest player to the roster. Please handwrite their full name, unique jersey number, player identification number and birthday below the existing rostered players.

Note: US Club Soccer teams may only take guest players registered under US Club Soccer, and USYSA teams may only take guest players registered with properly stamped USYSA player pass cards. No roster may be comprised of players with different passes from different organizations (no "mixed rosters").



Frequently Asked Questions

Questions Regarding Payments

When do I submit my payments?

- Application payments are due by October 25th

What are the fees for the tournament?

- U15-U16: \$700
- U17 -U19: \$725

Is the performance bond a separate fee from the application fee? When do I mail in the performance bond?

- Yes, teams must submit a check in the amount of \$300, this fee applies to the following age groups: U15-U19
- The performance bond should be mailed in with the application fee, on or before October 25th

What is the purpose of the performance bond?

- The purpose of a performance bond is to ensure that the schedules are maintained and that the facilities are being utilized properly. The performance bond is lost if there are any violations of the tournament which includes forfeits or destruction of property.

What happens to my performance bond after the tournament?

- If there are any violations of tournament regulations, the bond will be cashed by the tournament.
 - For example, behavioral misconduct or forfeited games.
- If no violations occur, the bond will be destroyed [unless otherwise noted].

Are referee fees included in the application fee?

- Yes, the referee fee is included in the application fee.



Frequently Asked Questions (Continued)

Questions Regarding Acceptance List and Rosters

How do I know if I have been accepted?

- Log onto gotsoccer.com, click on “application status” in the top menu. In the left column, you will see accepted, “yes” or “no.”
 - You can also see the accepted teams list on the tournament homepage

How do I update my roster on gotsoccer.com?

- Log onto gotsoccer.com, at the top menu there is a link for roster and results
 - Update your roster as needed.

Questions Regarding Scores and Schedules

Who reports the scores after a game?

- There will be a field marshal at each location that will collect and report the scores to the site coordinator. A representative of the team (coach, assistant coach, or team manager) must sign off on the score sheet that the field marshal has.

If scores are wrong on the website, who do I contact?

- Contact the Tournament Directors by e-mail as soon as your scores are submitted

What do I do if I have scheduling conflicts?

- Contact the Tournament Directors by e-mail

If I have a complaint during the event, whom do I contact?

- First contact the field marshal for your field, if the issue is not resolved, you may contact the site coordinator at your complex
- Please send an official team representative to the head quarters tent for complaints (an official team representative is the coach or team manager).
