

What To Do If You Are Sick

- If you are sick or have any symptoms, stay home, or remain in your hotel room.
- If you develop symptoms on-site, you need to leave the field and facility.
- Let tournament staff know immediately. There is a tracing form that will need to be filled out and messaging for specific teams will follow.

Teams

- Teams are not permitted to have post-game handshakes or “high-fives”. Applauding is the preferred method.
- Once your game is complete, please leave the field immediately so the next teams can enter the bench area promptly but remain socially distant. Entering teams should wait until the prior teams are completely removed from the bench area.
- Hydration stations will not be provided.
- Parents or spectators are not allowed in the team bench area.

Facility

- You will be required to wear a mask in the restrooms and any indoor spaces. There is signage posted in these areas.
- While it is not required to wear your mask when walking through the facility, it is encouraged.
- We do ask that you stay socially distant and go directly to the field where your team is playing. When the game is over, please leave the field immediately so there is separation for the teams playing the game after.
- We ask all spectators to practice social distancing on the sidelines and do not gather in groups larger than five (5).
